The Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made with Hertfordshire County Council ("the County Council") under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Authorities (Arrangements for the Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 in exercise of the powers conferred on the said County Council by Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 45, 46, 47, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

Commencement

"All Zones Business Permit" means a permit issued in accordance with Article ADD1 of this Order;

After the relevant Article relating to Business permit issuance and eligibility:

ADD1) Any tradesperson who does not live at the eligible address may apply for the issue of an All-Zones Business Permit for the use when visiting households in the roads specified in Schedule(s) to this Order, as well as other Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council's on street parking permit zones. Permits will be issued to a particular vehicle. The decision to issue an All-Zones Business Permit will be at the discretion of the Council. Insert an additional line at the end of each Schedule table relating to Allocation of Parking Permits and Parking Vouchers:

All Zones Business Permit Allocated and limited at Council's discretion

Insert an additional line at the end of each Schedule table relating to the Charges for Parking Permits and Parking Vouchers:
