Hollybush North parking review

Dear Occupier,

The parking survey post implementation review that was conducted in your area between June 2025 and September 2025 has been now concluded and this letter is to advise you that following parking restrictions will be formally proposed in the area on Wednesday 26 November 2025.

Double Yellow Lines

The proposal to introduce three sections of double yellow lines on the Southern kerbline of Burrowfield, two will be between Southfield and East Burrowfield. The third will be between East Burrowfield ending opposite West Burrowfield. The placement of these lines is taking into account comments received regarding vehicles having limited vision when exiting and entering the Industrial Estate.

The public notice will be advertised in the Welwyn Hatfield Times on Wednesday 26 November 2025. Public notices will also be placed on lamp columns in the affected road.

Formal objections to the proposals can be made using the details in the public notice published in the newspaper and on our website.

Any comments/objections to the proposed parking restrictions need to be submitted as per instructions on the public notice, so they can be considered by Parking Services and CPPP (Cabinet Planning and Parking Panel).
