

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING**

### **WELWYN HATFIELD BOROUGH COUNCIL**

## **THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (VARIOUS ROADS, WELWYN) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 202X**

Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council (pursuant to arrangement made with Hertfordshire County Council) proposes to introduce waiting restrictions in **Various Roads, Welwyn** under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The general effect of the Order would be to introduce double yellow lines in the following roads:

### **Double Yellow Lines (applies at any time)**

Parts of Blakes Way, Broomfield Close, Broomfield Road, Carleton Rise, Church Street, Codicote Road, Cylers Thicket, Dicket Mead, Elmoor Avenue, Elmoor Close, Fulling Mill Lane, Grange Hill, Hawbush Close, Hawbush Rise, Kindersley Close, Lockleys Drive, London Rd, Norman Road, North Ride, Parkside, Roman Way, Saxon Road, St Johns Close, St Mary's Close, Stuart Road, The Crescent, Tudor Road, Wilga Road, Wilshire Road, Windsor Road, Wingate Gardens, York Way.

It is intended that these measures will:

- **Reduce instances of inappropriate or inconsiderate parking including on junctions**
- **Reduce congestion**
- **Improve road safety**

The proposals have been developed following a consultation with residents, Borough and County Councillors, Hertfordshire County Council, Hertfordshire Constabulary and all other statutory consultees, taking into account Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
