Parking Consultation Update

Dear Resident

A parking consultation survey was conducted from 31 July 2025 to 26 September 2025, and 565 out of 2,225 properties (25.4%) within the consultation area responded.

At this stage, no decision has been made regarding parking restrictions. The suggestions below are based on the survey data, where residents expressed concerns about parking issues, and discussions with ward Councillors. We now require your further feedback to help determine the way forward.

Proposed Parking Restrictions

After reviewing all responses, the following outlines what parking restrictions we suggest:

Double Yellow Lines

Parking on bends and junctions was reported as an issue. Double yellow lines will be considered for introduction at all junctions where they do not already exist. In line with the Highway Code, these markings would typically extend 10 metres from the junction to maintain visibility and safety. These proposals apply only to the public highway and not to any private roads.

Please note:

No other restrictions, such as resident permits or verge/footway parking prohibitions, are being suggested at this stage.
