Notice of intent for parking restrictions

Dear Occupier,

The parking survey and informal consultation that was carried out in your area between July 2025 and September 2025 has now concluded and this letter is to advise you that the following parking restrictions will be formally proposed in the area on Wednesday 13 May 2026.

Double Yellow Lines

The proposal relates to introduction of double yellow lines mainly on junctions in parts of Blakes Way, Broomfield Close, Broomfield Road, Carleton Rise, Church Street, Codicote Road, Cylers Thicket, Dicket Mead, Elmoor Avenue, Elmoor Close, Fulling Mill Lane, Grange Hill, Hawbush Close, Hawbush Rise, Kindersley Close, Lockleys Drive, London Rd, Norman Road, North Ride, Parkside, Roman Way, Saxon Road, St Johns Close, St Mary's Close, Stuart Road, Tudor Road, Wilga Road, Wilshire Road, Windsor Road, Wingate Gardens and York Way.

The public notice will be advertised in the Welwyn Hatfield Times on Wednesday 13 May 2026 which will commence a 21-day objection period. Public notices will also be placed on lamp columns in the affected roads.

Any comments/objections to the proposed parking restrictions need to be submitted in writing as per instructions on the public notice, which will be published in the newspaper and on our website, so they can be considered by Parking Services and CPPP (Cabinet Planning and Parking Panel).
