We want to hear from local residents, businesses and visitors on the proposal.



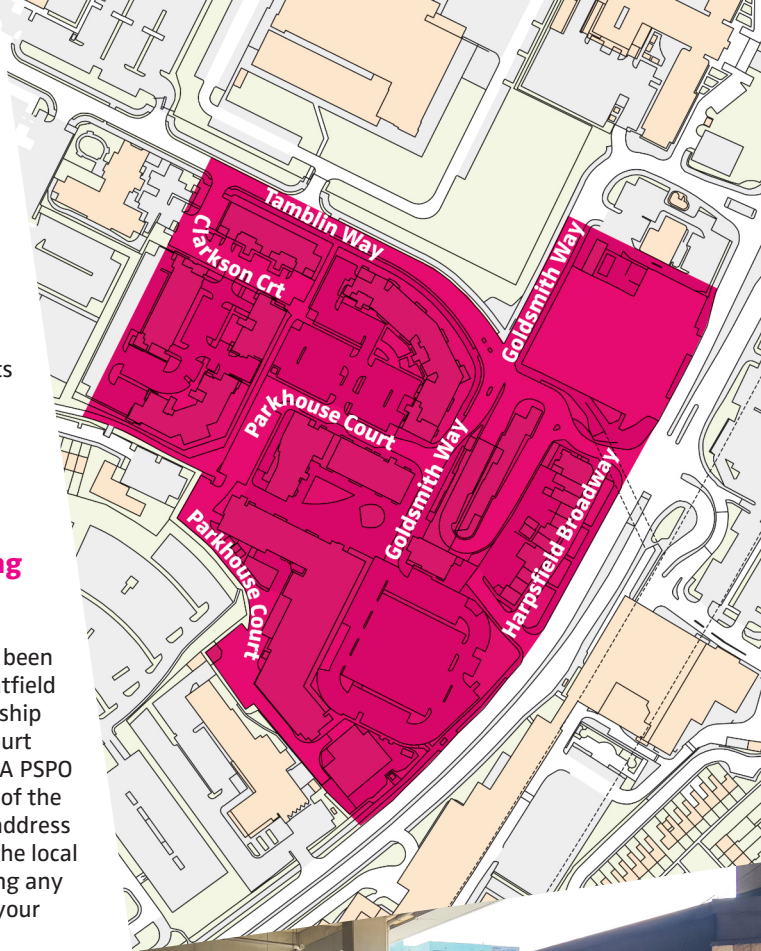

What is a PSPO?

A Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO) is intended to deal with behaviours and problems that have a negative impact on the local community's quality of life. A PSPO can introduce restrictions or requirements within a designated public area to help prevent anti-social behaviour and make public spaces safer for everyone.

Why are we proposing a PSPO?

Concerns about persistent anti-social behaviour have been raised with the Welwyn Hatfield Community Safety Partnership in relation to Parkhouse Court and the surrounding area. A PSPO is being considered as one of the measures that could help address these issues and improve the local environment. Before making any decision, we want to hear your views.
