Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council (pursuant to arrangements made with Hertfordshire County Council) proposes to introduce waiting restrictions in **Various Roads, Hollybush, Welwyn Garden City** under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended). The amendment is in order to introduce additional sections of double yellow lines following a review of the parking restrictions introduced in 2025.

The general effect of the Order would be to introduce additional parking restrictions in the following roads:

Double Yellow Lines

Burrowfield

Two Acres

It is intended that these measures will:

- **Reduce instances of inappropriate or inconsiderate parking**
- **Improve access to adjacent properties**

(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2026**

Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council (pursuant to arrangements made with Hertfordshire County Council) proposes to amend parking restrictions **Various Roads, Hollybush, Welwyn Garden City** under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended). The amendment is in order to adjust the boundaries displayed on Traffic Regulation Order maps relating to verge and footway prohibitions following a review of the parking restrictions introduced in 2025.

The general effect of the Order would be to make some minor administrative adjustments on map plans to reflect correct parking enforcement in the following roads:

1. This Order may be cited as "**The Borough of Welwyn Hatfield (Various Roads, Hollybush, Welwyn Garden City) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting on Verge or Footway) Order 2025 (Amendment) Order 2026**" and shall come into effect on **Monday 14 September 2026**
