NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made with Hertfordshire County Council, proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the proposed Order is to amend **The Borough of Welwyn Hatfield (Various Roads, Welham Green) (Restriction of Waiting and Permit Parking Zone) Order 2025** by extending eligibility for resident parking permits within Zone F04, as set out in the Schedule to this Notice.
