



Linking Hertfordshire towns and countryside, the Great North Way forms a north south cycle route through the County over 32 miles. Look out for the National Cycle Network '12' signs in Welwyn Garden City, Hatfield and Welham Green.

From Welwyn Garden City the greenway provides the gateway to explore the beautiful Ayot countryside. Follow the old railway line through Sherrardspark Woods all the way to Wheathampstead. The trail is open to walkers and cyclists.

Providing a green route between Hatfield House and St Albans Abbey, this 6½ mile trail can be used by walkers and cyclists. The paths makes an ideal day trip to St Albans being close to the town centre, Verulamium Park and the Abbey.
