## **Parking Consultation – Station Road Area, Cuffley**

Parking Services is currently carrying out a parking consultation within the Station Road area.

A consultation has already taken place with the businesses regarding parking in Station Road. It has been identified during this consultation that the permit holders only bay outside 48-54 Station Road - the bays immediately on the right when exiting Lambs Close - are not being used by permit holders as there is sufficient parking within Lambs Close during the permit restriction times (Mon-Fri 11am-1pm).

It is proposed to change these bays to match the parking provision offered outside shops to Monday-Saturday 8am-6:30pm 30 minutes no return within 1 hour. Also proposed is to replace in Station Road and Maynard Place some sections of Single Yellow Line with Double Yellow Lines to ensure obstructive parking does not occur at any time. We would like to give residents the opportunity to give feedback to these proposals before we progress onto the formal stage of advertising the proposed restrictions. On the reverse of this letter is a map showing the proposed parking restrictions within the road.

### **Double Yellow Lines**

Double yellow lines can only be used in areas where you want to prevent all parking; they are best used near junctions or busy main roads. Double yellow lines apply 24 hours a day seven days a week. They apply equally to non-residents, residents and visitors. No signs are needed.

### **Single Yellow Lines**

Single yellow lines can be used in areas where you want to prevent parking for part of the day. Single yellow lines apply equally to non-residents, residents and visitors. Signs are required near the start and end of each line and a sign must be erected every 60 metres.

Disabled Badge Holders do have a concession to park on a yellow line (without a loading restriction) for up to 3 hours when displaying a valid Disabled Badge and clock.

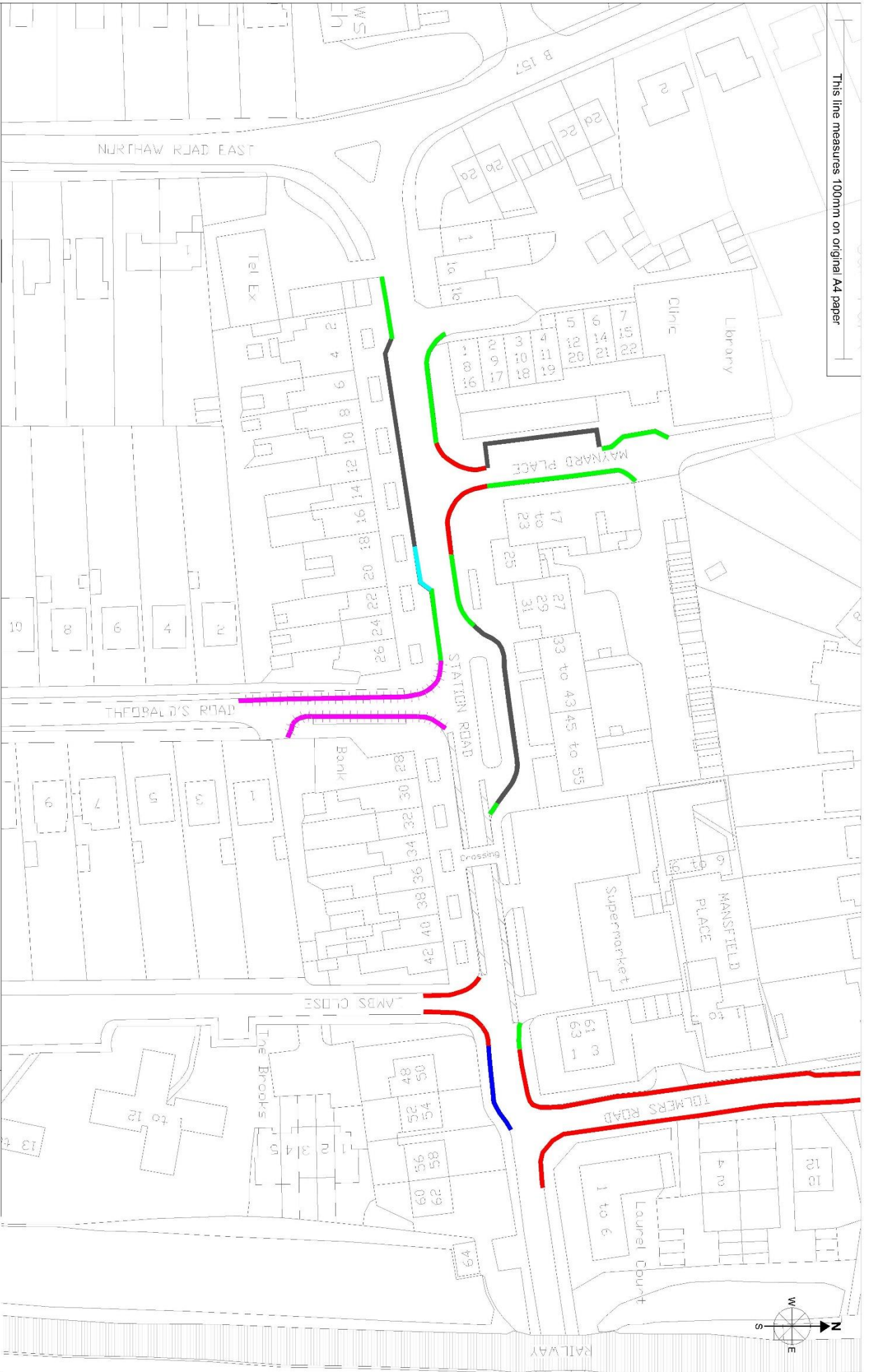
