Dear Resident/Occupier,

Parking Consultation – Permit Parking

During July 2018 the residents in your road were consulted about a proposal for additional double yellow lines in Dellsome Lane, Station Road and Somers Road. There was a low response with three votes in favour of the proposal and none against. Following that consultation we received a late request from a resident in Welham Close to consider a resident permit parking scheme. The request was made on the grounds that parking conditions will change significantly with the introduction of new yellow lines in the surrounding roads.

If this consultation receives a positive response from more than half the addresses in the road, a permit scheme will be added to the final proposal.

If you would like to comment on the proposals, please study the enclosed documents carefully, complete the survey form and return it in the envelope provided. Resident Permit Parking Schemes Information Sheet

The only type of parking restriction which can allow parking for both residents and their visitors, but prevent non-residents from parking, is called a Resident Permit Parking Scheme.

Resident Permits and Visitor Permits

- Vehicles parked on hardstands or inside garages on private property do not need permits or visitor permits.
- Residents who are Blue Badge Holders and own or drive a vehicle will not be charged for the first permit*.
- Residents providing proof of receiving a state pension may buy visitor permits at a 50% discounted rate**.
- Residents must also supply visitor permits to tradespersons that park in the permit area.
- Visitor permits are not required to load / unload vehicles or to drop off or pick up passengers.

Charges

Motorcycle permits - £10 per year

First permit - £25 per year*

Second permit - £40 per year

Third or subsequent permits - £60 per year

Business permit - £225 per year

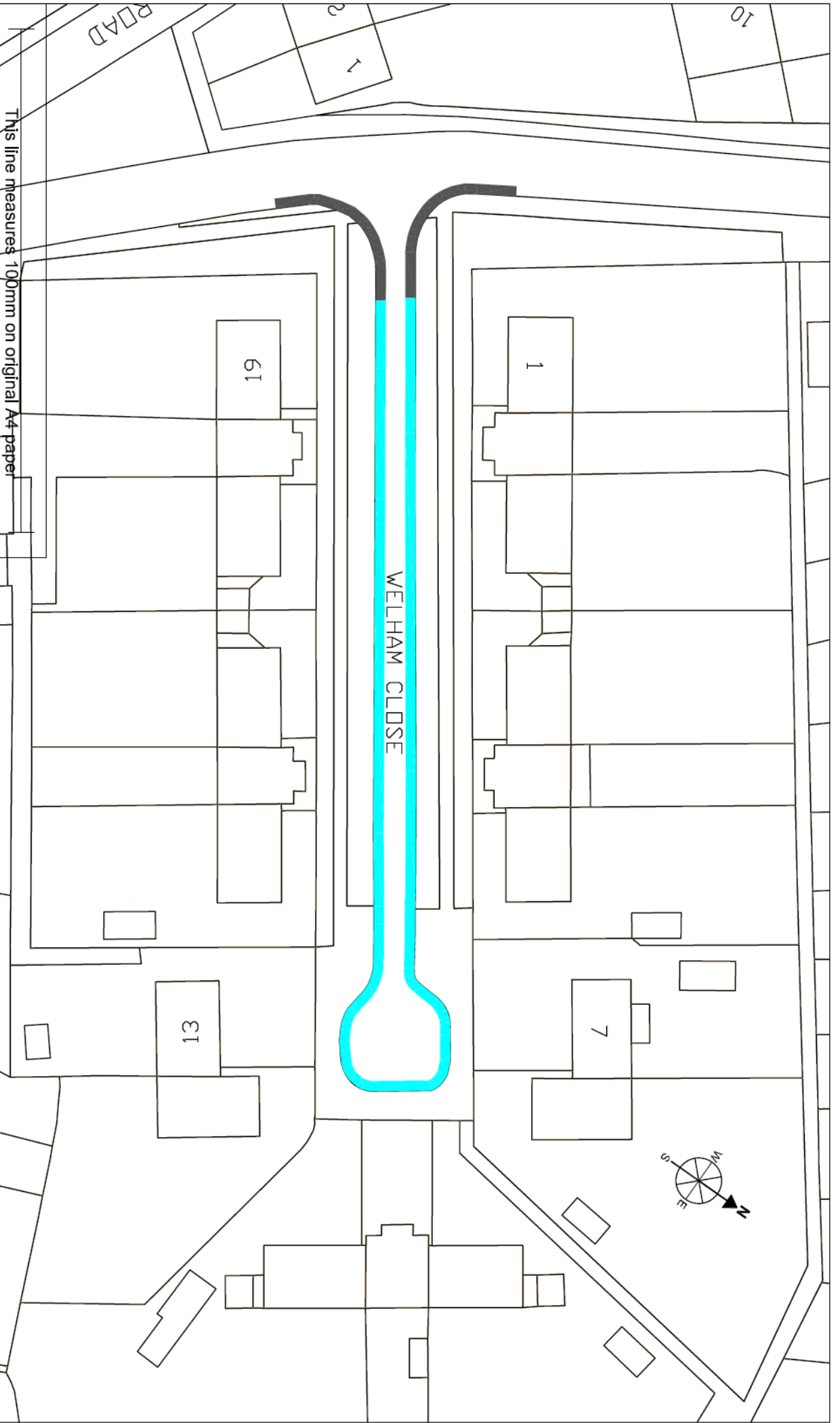
Doctors/Health Visitor permits - £20 per year

Visitor Permits - £10 for 20 x 1 day visitor permits**

Please note

- Permits will not be issued to vehicles that are larger than 5.25m long by 2.3m high.
- Permits and visitor permits are not interchangeable and must be used in conjunction with the permit zone/area for which they were issued.
- Any vehicle parked without a valid permit or visitor permit may receive a Penalty Charge Notice.
- Purchasing a permit does not entitle drivers to park on verges, pavements or yellow lines.
