STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (VARIOUS ROADS, CUFFLEY) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 2019

THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (STATION ROAD, CUFFLEY) (PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2019

Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council is proposing to introduce parking restrictions in **Various Roads, Cuffley**.

The proposed restrictions are as follows;

Prohibition of Loading and Unloading (“No Loading”) Monday to Saturday 8am to 6:30pm

- In parts of Theobalds Road and Station Road – to prevent loading and unloading on the existing double yellow lines

No waiting at any time (Double Yellow Lines)

- In parts of Brookside Crescent, Colesdale, Maynard Place and Station Road

Parking Limited to 30 minutes with no return within the next 1 hour Monday to Saturday 8am to 6:30pm (30 Minutes free)

- In parts of Station Road

Disabled Badge Holders Only at any time

- In parts of Station Road

The residents and businesses of the roads were consulted in late 2017 on proposed restrictions to prevent obstructive parking on junctions and parking congestion. The proposals are intended to stop obstructive parking during times of the day when traffic flow issues exist, and to make more accessible parking bays available for local shoppers.

Having considered the duty imposed by Section 122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council consider that it is necessary and expedient to make Orders for the following reasons:-

- **For the purposes of relieving or preventing congestion of traffic.**
- **For the avoidance of danger to persons or other traffic using the road and preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.**

The proposal has been subject to consultation with local and county councillors representing the area and Hertfordshire County Council. The local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, and local residents and businesses have also been consulted.
