Notes:

- 1 The built-up area lying in the open space in the south was Parsonage Farm which can be seen on the Tithe Map of 1883. The ponds associated with the farm are still in existence today.
- 2 It was envisaged that a school, or schools, would be suitable in the open space to the south of the built-up area.
