THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (VARIOUS ROADS, HANDSIDE, WELWYN GARDEN CITY) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING ON VERGE OR FOOTWAY) ORDER 2017

Dear **XXXXXXXXXXXX**,

The above proposal due to be heard before a meeting of the Cabinet Planning and Parking Panel on 4th October 2018 was deferred in order to convene an open meeting with residents. Following a forum with residents on 24th October 2018, the matter was adjourned for further investigation.

A meeting was held today with all three Ward Councillors and County Councillor for this area present and officers from both Welwyn Hatfield and Hertfordshire County Council. On the agenda was the objections received from residents relating to Honeycroft, it has been decided that the existing vehicle crossovers will no longer form part of the verge protection order; neither will a resident parking permit be required to park on the vehicle crossovers. These will now be removed from the permit parking area, therefore parking can continue as it is currently. Residents of Honeycroft will still be eligible to purchase permits and visitor vouchers for use in the bays provided in Parkway (Zone A10).

This letter is to inform residents of Honeycroft who have previously submitted formal objections to the above proposal that these will now be considered by the Council's Cabinet Planning and Parking Panel (CPPP) on **Thursday, 10th January 2019**. In light of this change to the proposals, should you now wish to withdraw your formal objection then please notify the Council. The meeting will be held at 7.30pm in the Council Chamber on the ground floor of the Council Offices, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City, AL8 6AE.
