NOTICE OF INTENT – STATUTORY CONSULTATION

THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (LAMBS CLOSE, CUFFLEY) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PERMIT PARKING ZONE) ORDER 2019

In April 2019 we wrote to residents detailing the outcome of the parking consultation. The majority of responses from residents did not want the permit restriction days and times to be changed.

Northaw and Cuffley Parish Council requested that Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council manage the Lambs Close permit scheme, as we manage all other council resident permit schemes within the borough.

To transfer the scheme to WHBC, a new Traffic Regulation Order needs to be made to include visitor vouchers for the first time for residents. Included in our proposals will be to amend the parking bays on the west side of Lambs Close to remove the single yellow line between the bays and amend the bay markings for additional parking space. This will also reduce on signage posts required on that side of the road. We are also proposing to amend the remaining single yellow lines within the road to double yellow lines to stop obstructive parking from occurring in evenings and weekends.

Please note: Residents in The Brooks will not be eligible for parking permits or vouchers due to dedicated off street parking in front of the properties. All other current eligible addresses will still be able to buy permits or vouchers.

Please note this letter is relating to the advertisement of the traffic regulation order which we have a duty to make all residents aware of, at this stage the new parking restrictions (yellow lines) have not been confirmed and no start date is available at the moment.

The legal documents relating to the parking restrictions (Traffic Regulation Orders) have been drafted. The documents will be published in the Welwyn Hatfield Times on **Wednesday 12th June 2019**. Notices will also be placed on lamp columns near the lengths of the road affected. Anyone wishing to object to the proposed parking restrictions may write to the Council using the details supplied in the Public Notice. All objections must be submitted by **Friday 5th July 2019**. Any

previous concerns raised in our survey forms are not classed as a formal objection, and the above process will need to be followed to lodge an objection against these proposals.

Objections to the proposals will be considered by the Cabinet Planning and Parking Panel (CPPP) at the meeting on Thursday 1st August 2019. CPPP will also consider Parking Services' report giving reasons for proceeding with the proposals. The recommendations made by CPPP will be considered by the Cabinet on Tuesday 6th August 2019. Both meetings will be held in the Council Chamber on the ground floor of the Council Offices, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City AL8 6AE.

Parking Services will keep all objectors informed by letter during the decision making process. Once this process has ended, we will write to all residents and businesses within the affected area with the outcome.
