

**WELWYN HATFIELD BOROUGH COUNCIL**

**STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING**

**THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (LAMBS CLOSE, CUFFLEY) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PERMIT PARKING ZONE) ORDER 2019**

Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council is proposing to introduce a resident parking permit zone and “no waiting at any time” (double yellow lines) restrictions in Lambs Close, Cuffley.

The residents of the road were consulted in 2019 on changing the current resident parking permit provision from Northaw and Cuffley Parish Council to Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council. It was also highlighted of some parking congestion on current single yellow lines within the road.

Having considered the duty imposed by Section 122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council consider that it is necessary and expedient to make Orders for the following reasons:-

- **In order to provide suitable and adequate parking facilities**
- **For the purposes of relieving or preventing congestion of traffic.**
- **For the avoidance of danger to persons or other traffic using the road and preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.**

The proposed restrictions are as follows:

**Parking permit parking places, zone E05 Monday - Friday, 11am - 1pm**

- In parts of Lambs Close

**No waiting at any time (double yellow lines)**

- Parts of Lambs Close

The proposal has been subject to consultation with borough and county councillors representing the area and Hertfordshire County Council. The local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, and local residents and businesses have also been consulted.
