## **LEMSFORD ROAD, HATFIELD – NOTICE OF INTENTION**

New waiting restrictions in the Lemsford Road area came into force on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2019. It is normal practice to monitor the effectiveness of any new restrictions in the first few months following implementation to determine if any further intervention is required.

Visibility has improved particularly around the bend in Lemsford Road where previously vehicles coming from either direction could not see approaching traffic. Residents living in Middlefield, Oak Tree Close etc have also reported an improvement in visibility in emerging from their streets onto Lemsford Road. However residents elsewhere have reported a change in parking pattern whereby some vehicles are now parking on the other side of the road greatly reducing the visibility for drivers emerging from Worcester Road. As a matter of urgency the Council now proposes to install additional double yellow line junction protection to address this problem.

Legal documents relating to these proposed changes have now been drafted. A public notice will be published in the Welwyn Hatfield Times on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2019. Notice boards will also be erected near the lengths of road affected. Anyone wishing to object to the proposed parking restrictions may write to the Council by 18<sup>th</sup> September 2019 using the details supplied in the public notice. All objections to the proposals will be considered by the Cabinet Planning and Parking Panel (CPPP) (date to be confirmed). CPPP will also consider the Parking Services' report giving reasons for proceeding with the proposals. The recommendations made by CPPP will be considered by the Cabinet (date to be confirmed). Both meetings will be held in the Council Chamber on the ground floor of the Council Offices, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City, AL8 6AE.

Parking Services will keep objectors informed during the decision process. Once the decision process has ended Parking Services will write to all residents in the affected roads. If you have any questions about the consultation process please do not hesitate to contact us


