

REPRESENTATIONS OF B.P. MITCHELL

I act for BP Mitchell who own both of the waste sites within the Garden Suburb (Eco Aggregates at Birchall Lane and Burnside off the Hertford Road). We have the following comments regarding the green corridor:

- We are generally supportive of the aspirations and objectives of the corridor
- We are concerned with all three options, as each is channelling people and wildlife close to active waste management sites. This land use relationship is fractious and it would be prudent to site corridors away from these permanent existing uses
- Options 1 and 2 are essentially diverting an existing path within the wood westwards towards the Eco Aggregates site. We consider that the corridor should be on the eastern, not the western side of Greater Captains/Holwell Park Wood
- Options 2 and 3 are channelling people and wildlife close to the Burnside site boundary. We consider that the corridor should be moved northwards at that location, away from the site.
- A fusion of the options is considered to be the most appropriate – with the southern part of Option 1 and the northern part of Option 3 fused together to cite the corridors away from the waste management sites
