Hill Top Car Park, South Hatfield – Revised Proposals

Further to the letter dated the 5th December the Council sent before Christmas, regarding the proposals to introduce limited waiting restrictions in Hill Top car park.

Just to recap, the construction for the High View development will be a phased, the first phase will mean removing two of the three car parks for construction to start. This only leaves one relatively small car park Hill Top which currently has no parking restrictions in place.

In order to deter long term parking, the Council did propose to introduce a 2-hour parking restriction which will create better turnover of space, and ensure that shoppers can access parking as close as possible to businesses within the High View neighbourhood centre. The proposed restrictions would apply Monday to Friday 8:00am to 6:00pm.

Two businesses have contacted the council requesting the limited waiting be changed from 2 hours to 3 hours, as there are some activities which would take longer than the proposed 2 hours. Please find the amended plan enclosed, showing the extent of the proposed parking restrictions.
