## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (DIGSWELL PARK ROAD CAR PARK) (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2010

The Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, hereinafter called "the Council", in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Sections 32, 33, 34, 35 and 35A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), hereinafter referred to as "the Act" and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-



1. This Order shall come into operation on 1 December 2010 and may be cited as "The Borough of Welwyn Hatfield (Digswell Park Road Car Park) (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 2010" (hereinafter referred to as "this Order").
2. The Schedule to the Welwyn Hatfield District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1995 ("the order of 1995") shall be amended to add therein Digswell Park Road Car Park as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The maximum period a vehicle may wait in Digswell Park Road Car Park specified in Column 5 of the Schedule to the Order of 1995 shall be 20 minutes, no return within 20 minutes, between 9.00am and 11.00am on Monday to Friday inclusive.
4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

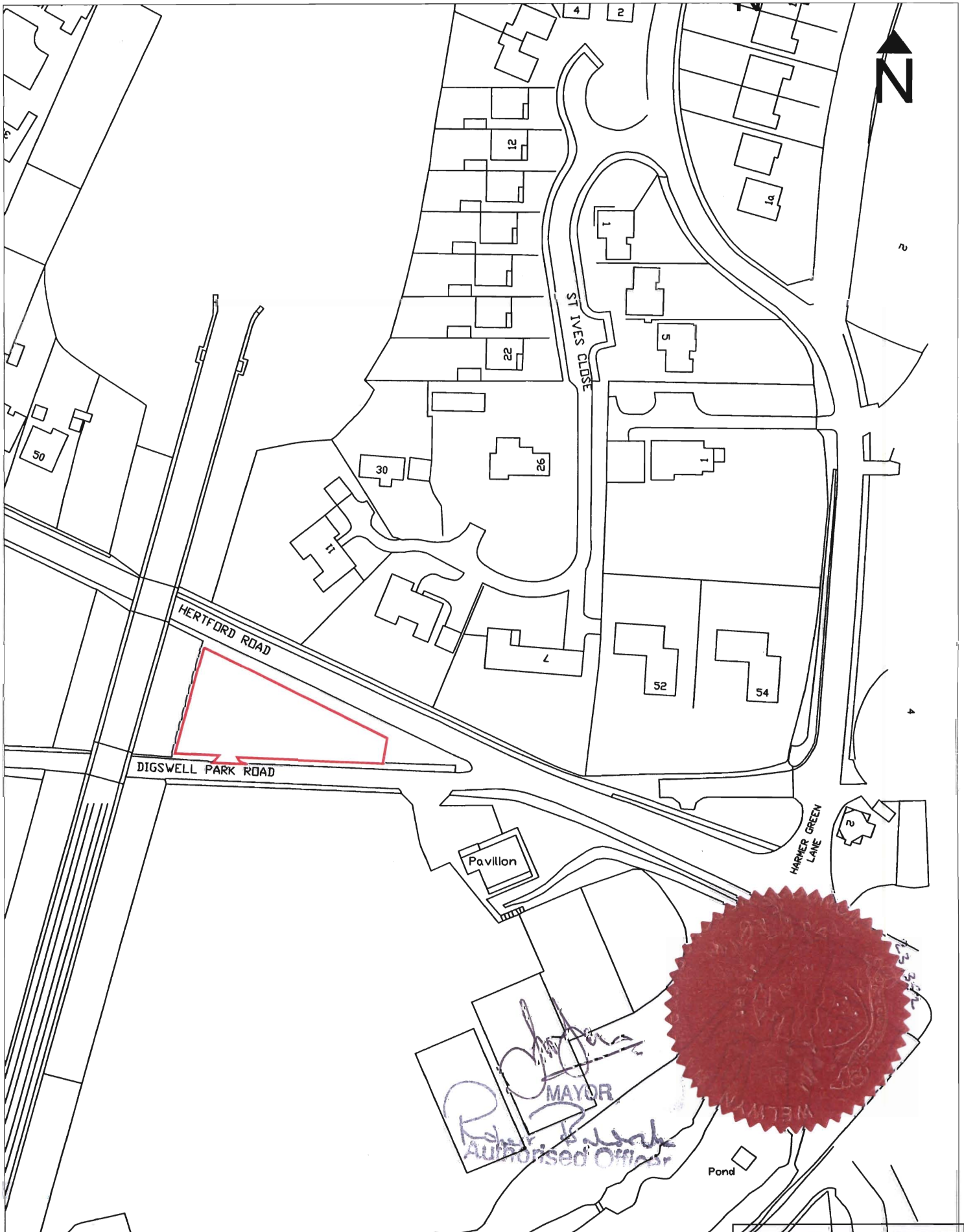

THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (WARREN WAY, FOXLEY GROVE, HAZEL CLOSE, WOODSIDE ROAD  
and COB LANE CLOSE, DIGSWELL, WELWYN) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND PERMIT PARKING ZONE)  
ORDER 2010

NOTICE is given that Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council (pursuant to arrangements made with Hertfordshire County Council) has made Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The general effect of the Orders will be to introduce additional Off Street waiting restrictions, new On Street Waiting restrictions and a new Permit Parking Zone in parts of Digswell as specified in the Schedules to this Notice. The Orders will come into force on Wednesday 1 December 2010.

Documents giving full details of the proposals are contained in the Orders, the plans and the statement of reasons which may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, The Campus, Welwyn Garden City or viewed at [www.welhat.gov.uk](http://www.welhat.gov.uk) from 24 November 2010 until 5 January 2011.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders, or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from the date of this Notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

**SCHEDULE 1**

**Off Street Parking Restrictions** – that car park listed below as set out in the Order and accompanying plans  
Digswell Park Road Car Park - Limited waiting free of charge parking places – limited to a maximum of 20 minutes waiting with no return within 20 minutes effective 9:00am to 11:00am Monday to Friday. Restricted to the following classes of vehicle; motorcar, motor cycles, invalid carriages and goods vehicles with a maximum gross weight not exceeding 3.5 tonnes and a height not exceeding 2.3 metres.

## STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

### THE BOROUGH OF WELWYN HATFIELD (DIGSWELL PARK ROAD CAR PARK) (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2010

Following consideration of recent concerns raised by local residents and parents at St Johns Primary School, Digswell about long term commuter parking in Digswell Park Road Car Park (locally known as the Viaduct Car Park) Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council is proposing to introduce limited waiting restrictions between 9.00am and 11.00am Monday to Friday, 20 minutes, no return within 20 minutes.

The reason for proposing to make this order is to deter long term commuter parking and to enable parking during peak hours for those persons wishing to use local amenities such as the recreational facilities, the local church and school.

Consultation has been carried out with users of the car park, the Police and the County Council and the proposal was considered at meetings of Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council's Cabinet Planning and Transportation Panel on 12 January 2010 and Cabinet on 2 February 2010.
